Goal kicks in division 6 has been changed to have the referee hand the ball to the goal keeper who may punt, pass, roll, or throw the ball up field as the restart. (division 5 has normal goal kicks as a restart. One re-throw is allowed on a throw-in foul for the first 4 weeks of the season Opponents must be 8 yards from any free kick in division 5 and 6 yards from any free kick in division 6 Offside in division 6 will not be called, talk to coaches if players are cherry picking.

In all divisions NO casts of any kind, NO splint of any kinds, NO Hard Jewelry, NO Ear Piercing Studs even if covered by tape (NO exceptions).

In divisions 1-6 there is a coin toss, called by the away team captain, before each game.

The winner of the coin toss chooses the goal to defend, the loser of the coin toss kicks off to start of the game.
